

# ASYRA PRO OPERATORS MANUAL

STOP PRESS ! – 9<sup>th</sup> June 2009 Issues playing some videos even if you have followed the guidelines below may be resolved by downloading the VLC player from [www.videolan.com](http://www.videolan.com) and viewing through that player. We are awaiting some re-encoded videos.

The operators manual for the Asyra Pro is contained on a series of instructional videos that are stored within the Asyra Pro directory on the hard drive of the PC where it is installed.

The video files may be viewed using Windows Media Player version 11 or above. (They may work with earlier versions but could be unreliable.) If you go into the Help section in the software, you can view the videos through a version of Media Player that is embedded in the software. If for some reason this is not convenient, you can view the files by opening Media Player on your computer and selecting the file you want to watch.

The suite of videos has been created to cover all aspects of using the system, from initial set-up, through setting up tests, to printing results and using the test plate.

## **NOTE ON WINDOWS MEDIA PLAYER**

The version of Windows Media Player that was shipped with Windows XP was version 9, so it is necessary for most XP users to download an upgrade in order to properly view the files.

Some installations of media player, annoyingly do not show the File (and other) menus, by default. If all you can find in your media player is references to Play Lists etc, you may need to right-click in the command bar and choose 'Show Classic Menu'.
